

## FINANCE FACULTY POSITION

**POSITION:** The McColl School of Business at Queens University of Charlotte invites applications for a tenure track position in Finance at the Assistant/Associate Professor rank available beginning August 2018.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must hold an earned doctorate (PhD or DBA) in Finance from an accredited institution. The successful candidate will have teaching and research interests in finance. Candidates with a PhD in Economics will be considered provided they have substantial graduate coursework and active research in finance. Candidates who are ABD with substantial progress toward completing their doctorate may also be considered. Preference will be given to those who have teaching experience in Investments, Securities and Fixed Income Analysis, and International Finance. Experience working with or advising a student-managed investment club would be a plus (but is not required). Holding the CFA designation, or progress toward becoming a CFA charterholder would also be a plus, but again, is not required. Industry experience in finance would also be considered a plus.

**JOB RESPONSIBILITY:** Excellence in teaching and research is expected and supported. The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching classes at both the undergraduate and graduate level (six-courses per year); conducting research that leads to publications in respected, peer-reviewed journals; participating in school and university activities; and advising undergraduate business students. The successful candidate will be one who values interaction with students both in and out of the classroom.

**THE COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY:** Located just minutes from uptown Charlotte, Queens University is a private, co-ed, masters-level university serving more than 2,500 undergraduate and graduate students in academic programs across the liberal arts and sciences, as well as the professional fields of business, communication, nursing, health science, and education.
