

BSN ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

Students who accept an offer of admission to the nursing program must provide documentation of the following to the PSN office by the date indicated in the admissions letter. Failure to have this information in the PSN office by the required date may forfeit the admission invitation.

- ❑ Personal health insurance
- ❑ Physical examination completed within 12 months prior to admission to the major. Form may be downloaded at [http://www.queens.edu/upload/PresbyImmunizationFormsHighlighted\(3\).pdf](http://www.queens.edu/upload/PresbyImmunizationFormsHighlighted(3).pdf)
- ❑ Immunizations
 - as required by the college ([http://www.queens.edu/upload/PresbyImmunizationFormsHighlighted\(3\).pdf](http://www.queens.edu/upload/PresbyImmunizationFormsHighlighted(3).pdf))
 - Hepatitis B Series or Titer
 - The student has the right to accept or reject the hepatitis B vaccination, but the Hepatitis B Vaccine Option form must be signed annually indicating if the student declines.
 - Varicella (chickenpox) 2 doses or positive titer. (statement of disease is NOT acceptable)
- ❑ TB Test Status

Initially a two-step testing Tuberculin (PPD) test required. A negative PPD is required annually. A positive reading will necessitate the submission of Record of TB Screening; this form is available in the VPN office.
- ❑ Drug Screen (urine)

Negative urine drug screen obtained within 12 months prior to admission to the major.
- ❑ CPR certification – American Health Association Health Care Provider – Basic Life Support (BLS). Students are to maintain current CPR certification.
