LANGUAGE AND CULTURAL IMMERSION PROGRAMS

The four-week language and cultural immersion programs in French or Spanish allow students to have a more in-depth international experience in one location while earning six to nine credit hours. Queens students regularly study in France, Spain and Costa Rica; we have also sent students to Italy and Germany. The schools keep class sizes to a minimum, provide intensive grammar review and emphasize oral proficiency. Outside the classroom, the schools organize cultural activities suited to the students' interests: lectures, museum visits and excursions to regional attractions. Each student takes part in a "home-stay" that allows them to reside and eat many meals with a local family.

SEMESTER OR YEAR LONG EXCHANGE

Students have the option to study abroad at Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU), Queens University in Belfast, the University of Ulster in Coleraine (both in Northern Ireland) or the University of the Sunshine Coast, located near Brisbane in Queensland, Australia. In these programs, students continue to receive scholarships and other financial aid and may participate for about the same cost as a regular semester at Queens. Admission to any of these programs is through a selective admissions process.

CHARACTER

LOCATION

Total enrollment at the University exceeds 2200 students. Approximately 900 students are enrolled in the traditional undergraduate programs.

ATHLETICS

Teams compete in Division II of the NCAA and in Conference Carolinas. Queens has seven men's varsity teams and nine women's varsity teams.

Close to 90% of our students travel and study abroad. Queens offers language immersion, international internships, study tours and semester abroad opportunities.

INTERNSHIPS

At Queens, 100% of our students participate in career internships, which gives them a competitive edge when entering the work force. More than 350 organizations recruit and hire Queens students. The internship curriculum has a strong academic component and is focused on experiential learning.
