### CHARACTER

A private co-educational comprehensive university affiliated with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). Founded in 1857, the University offers a unique educational experience through engaging majors designed to integrate the liberal arts and sciences and professional studies.

### LOCATION

30-acre campus within the historic, park-like Charlotte neighborhood of Myers Park yet only ten minutes from downtown Charlotte, one of the nation's leading business, professional sports and cultural centers.

### STUDENTS

Total enrollment at the University exceeds 2200 students. Approximately 900 students are enrolled in the traditional undergraduate programs.

### ATHLETICS

Teams compete in Division II of the NCAA and in Conference Carolinas. Queens has seven men's varsity teams and nine women's varsity teams.

### JOHN BELK INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

In U.S. News & World Report's "America's Best Colleges 2008" publication, Queens University of Charlotte was listed in the top 5 of all colleges and universities in the U.S. for percentage of students who travel abroad. Close to 90% of our students travel and study abroad. Queens offers language immersion, international internships, study tours and semester abroad opportunities.

### INTERNSHIPS

At Queens, 100% of our students participate in career internships, which gives them a competitive edge when entering the work force. More than 350 organizations recruit and hire Queens students. The internship curriculum has a strong academic component and is focused on experiential learning.
