“Learning History by Doing History”

Funding for history majors awarded through the Preyer History Fellows Program will be given on a competitive basis to entering or currently enrolled Queens University of Charlotte students who meet the program requirements. Selection of the recipients will be made by the members of the History department, based on a review of the applicant’s academic ability and interest in this program. Recipients of Preyer History Fellowships must declare history as their major, enroll in two history courses during their first year at Queens and maintain a 3.0 overall GPA and a 3.1 GPA in their history courses.

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until all positions are filled, but priority for incoming freshmen will be given to those applications received by December 4th.
